Visits to historic and scenic Power Plant 1 are arranged for school classrooms, grades 5-college. Power Plant 1 is located about 50 miles north of Los Angeles and 12 miles above Saugus in the Angeles National Forest. The plant is a working hydroelectric plant built in 1917.

Each participating teacher receives a 90-page guide that includes numerous lessons in a variety of subjects including history, science and ecology. Lessons include information about the City of Los Angeles water and energy supply systems.

Each school is responsible for arranging and funding transportation.

**Tours:** The Port of Hueneme offers an excellent educational experience for students of all ages with tour content tailored to meet the educational needs of elementary, secondary and post secondary educational levels. Tours are generally divided into two sections, inside classroom style presentation followed by an outside tour by motorcoach. In general port tours take approximately an hour and a half to two hours but can be shortened to accommodate class schedules.

**Hours:** The Port of Hueneme is open to the public for tours Monday through Friday 8:00 a.m. through 5:00 p.m. School tours are particularly encouraged.
